
Rethinking

UI/UX Philosophy

- **Discoverability** functions easily found by users, minimizing need for help
- Familiarity use established UI design, elements and conventions
- **Simplicity** keep focus on God's Word and BSF study, remove confusion
- Clarity make the UI clear instead of clever













Designer Notes: This Onboarding Dialog will be used to present app features and new features. It will appear IF this is the first launch of the app on a new version.









Designer Notes: This Prayer reminder modal dialog will appear on certain conditions: IF the user enabled this in settings (by default it will be enabled) AND IF it hasn't already been shown that day AND IF any single day has uncompleted questions. Also, IF possible we want to build in the function of having several background images and several versions of the copy that will be randomly shown to give variety to the user.





Designer Notes: This second prayer modal follows if first prayer modal shows. The "cricle" will actually be an animation (animated GIF, PNG, h264 or other file).






Designer Notes: Text areas removed outline and now contain "type your response here...". Question number is "outdented" for better readability (we don't know if the data will easily handle this). Scripture buttons will not be inline but on their own line. Text size toggle will cycle through text display sizes (already a feature in CBSF app). Share icon will direct users to a new page.


Comparison - Scripture Sheet

New functionality



Designer Notes: This is new functionality to treat the Scripture view as a "sheet". When tapping a scripture button on the lesson the sheet raises to the 50% point animating from the bottom of the screen. A second tap on the "thumb" will extend it to the top (again animating) to utilize the full screen. If possible we would like the user to be able to drag the thumb up and down to resize the Bible viewer as desired. Scrolling should be active on both the scripture sheet and the lesson below. *Bible text view will be discussed on the next screen*.


Comparison - Bible Full Screen








Comparison - Bible Comparison Version



Designer Notes: When in "Comparison" mode, the Bible shows verses on separate lines and the comparison language is show in shaded areas.












New Screen




























